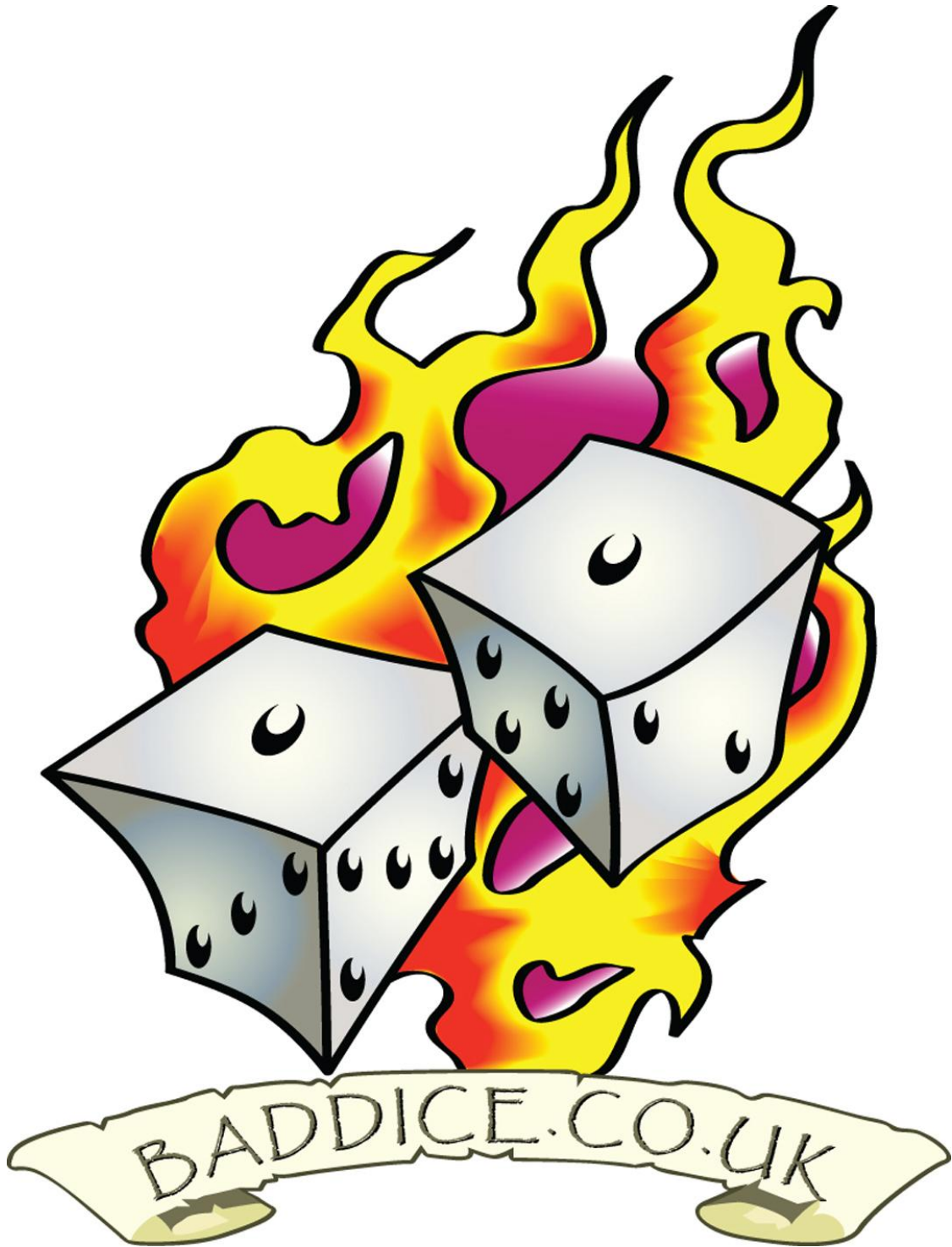

The 2010 WFB Masters

Army Composition

Armies are 2400 points and may be chosen from any army book currently available from Games Workshop.

The Masters will use the following restrictions.

- No named or special characters are allowed.
- The Power Scroll is banned.
- Characters will only take a single wound from the following spells that automatically kill models or automatically remove an entire regiment: Dwellers Below, Final Transmutation, Dreaded 13th, Infernal Gateway 11-12 effect.

Scoring System

Victory points are scored as per the rulebook with the following exceptions;

- Units fleeing at the end of the game count as destroyed.

Tournament points will be awarded as follows

- **Win = 30 points**
- **Draw = 10 points**
- **Loss = 0 points**

Scenarios

- All 6 pitched battles from the rulebook will be played in a random order.

Painting

Unpainted figures will not be allowed

Painting scores will be determined using the following criteria via tournament organiser judging:

- The army fully painted (3 colours minimum)? 5 points
- The bases are at least flocked? 5 points
- The army has movement trays for all units and war machines are based? 5 points
- The army looks like a cohesive force. (i.e. all 1 force and not borrowed from different armies). 5 points

All players will vote for their favourite army. The player with the most votes will receive the best painted army award.

Sportsmanship

At the Masters we expect players to know how to conduct themselves at the table. We also hope that the Masters atmosphere will be conducive to creating some memorable games. With this in mind there will not be any scoring for sportsmanship.

Winning the event

The player with the most points from both Battle and Painting (max of 200) will be crowned the 2010 Master

In the event of a tie the first decider will be results between the tied players if they have faced each other during the tournament. Ties will then be separated by victory points scored.

Army list Submission

Army lists must be submitted before 9pm on January 1st 2011. Late lists (including illegal list not corrected before the deadline) will receive a penalty of 30 tournament points with no exceptions for any reason. If you are unsure if you can meet the deadline, make sure you send your list in early.
